

Experiences in Ushuaia

Half Day National Park (4hs)

Season: year-round

In this tour you will discover the true nature of the secret within the National Park Tierra del Fuego. With a specialized guide it is possible to get to know in detail this recovered paradise that guards the southernmost forest of Argentina, and the fresh water of rivers and lakes mix with the sea.

Half Day National Park / Trekking (6hs)

Season: Oct to Apr

In this tour you will discover the true nature of the secret within the Tierra del Fuego National Park. You will walk through the forest along the shore of the Beagle Channel, and the bays Lapataia and Ensenada.

Full Day National Park/ Trekking + Canoeing (8hs)

Season: year-round

In this tour you will discover the true nature of the secret within the Tierra del Fuego National Park. You will walk through the forest, and canoeing down rivers, and across lagoons to get into the famous Lapataia Bay.

Full Day National Park + Beagle Navigation (10hs)

Season: Oct to Apr

In this tour you will discover the true nature of the secret within the Tierra del Fuego National Park. You will walk around 3 hours through the forest, along the shore of the Beagle Channel, and the bays Lapataia and Ensenada. On the way back from the National Park, you will head towards the tourist local wharf to start the Navigation crossing Ushuaia's wide Bay until reaching the Beagle Channel across Paso Chico. There you will sail around La Isla de los Pajaros where you will see skuas, albatros of black eyebrow, steamer ducks, cauquenes and dolphin gull; and la Isla de Lobos where you can observe seals of one and two hair. Both islands belong to the Archipelago Bridges. When come to the Les Eclaireurs Lighthouse (The Illuminators), you will be able to see the colonies of Imperial and Rock Cormorants; and also listen the history of the sinking SS of the Monte Cervantes who led in 1930.

Lakes Off-Road (8hs)

Season: year-round

Lakes Off-Road is an amusing, intense and friendly way to discover the secrets hidden behind the Southern Andes Range. From above the Andes, you'll get a view of Escondido Lake (Hidden Lake), a little wonder that hides at the bottom of a valley. Afterwards, the enormous Fagnano Lake, impressive and great, you'll be the main attraction.

Lakes Off-Road & Canoeing (9hs)

Season: Aug to Apr

In this tour you will visit several beautiful places. First you will visit Escondido Lake, to experience it, and to row in its waters during this tour that joins adventure, physical activity and fun. Then you will cross the Andes Range, and some big glacial valleys and peat bogs, at Garibaldi Pass, you'll get the first view of Escondido Lake. You will be driven by the coast of this lake to later go on its waters in very safe and stable canoes. Later you will take a tour in a 4x4 adventure, through impossible paths, you'll defy mud, water, fallen trees, and pot-holes. The drive will take you through the forest until reaching the endless shore of Fagnano Lake, one of the most pristine areas in Tierra del Fuego, where you will find shelter in the refuge, where you will have a delicious lunch with a Malbec wine.

Gable Island and penguin rookery (9hs)

Season: Oct 15th to Apr 15th

Gable Island is the tour for those who arrive in Ushuaia searching for the world's end. Away from the tourist-crowded areas, and in the middle of the Beagle Channel, this place is recommended worldwide by word-of-mouth. Gable Island offers us nature untouched and history in the present tense. During this full-day excursion the traveler goes for a ride, sails on a motor boat, walks and discovers. On your way to Gable Island you'll also see penguins.

Gable Island and penguin rookery /canoeing (10hs)

Season: Oct 15th to Apr 15th

This full-day excursion takes you for a ride, to navigate, to walk and to make discoveries in one of the roughest and most beautiful places in the Beagle Channel. You will enjoy of a canoeing adventure down the river that leads into the sea that ends in the Harborton port. After leaving the canoes you will take a trip on a motor boat towards Martillo Island, where you will have the chance to see penguins in their breeding lair. Then the motor boat take you to the main attraction at Gable Island, where you have some snacks, good wine and a delicious meal. Later you will take a hike to know more of this gorgeous island, crossing over beaver dams and through the forest to reach the Beagle Channel shore where you will take the boat to start your return to Ushuaia.

Meet the Beavers (5hs)

Season: Nov to Mar

Beaver encounter takes place in the evening, because that's the only time of day when they leave their lodges. You will close up on their habitat along challenging mud tracks, then, after kitting yourselves up on learning about their lives, you'll be enjoying a delicious stew under the impressive sunset.

Sea Kayak at Beagle Channel (6hs)

Season: Aug to Apr

This activity combines the lure of hiking and photographic safaris, from a perspective that expands the discovery area of the sea that man has sailed for more than 7,000 years ago. In double sea kayaks, you will sail bound to conquer uninhabited beaches and majestic places.
